POSITION SUMMARY:

Reporting to the Elders Coordinator, the Elders Support Worker provides practical, hands-on support to Elders participating in the Elders Group and related activities. This role focuses on logistics, transportation, comfort, and on-site support, ensuring Elders can participate safely and comfortably in community and program activities.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Assist Elders during gatherings, circles, and events
- Provide or assist with transportation to and from activities
- Assist with mobility, seating, and accessibility needs
- Ensure Elders are comfortable, safe, and supported
- Monitor and provide respectful assistance based on Elder needs and direction
- Help set up and clean up spaces respectfully
- Ensure meals, refreshments, and supplies are available
- Support cultural activities as guided by Elders
- Follow cultural protocols and instructions from Elders and Coordinator
- Support intergenerational activities with youth and families
- Communicate Elder needs or concerns to the Elders Coordinator
- Assist with tracking (attendance, transport logs, honoraria support)
- Maintain confidentiality and discretion
- Other duties as assigned.

- Respectful communication and listening skills
- Ability to provide physical and emotional support as appropriate
- Reliability and punctuality
- Cultural sensitivity and humility
- Ability to lift light items and assist with setup as needed
- Ability to work flexible hours

 - Comply with Fit for Duty policy and participate in mandatory pre-employment drug and alcohol test.
